Activities and Conversations: Talking and playing with your child are essential steps for their success in reading!

Let's Explore: Color!

Exploration #1

Use the included watercolor paints and paper to create crumpled paper art:

- 1. Crumple the paper and paint one color anywhere you want.
- 2. Paint a second color (or 3rd, 4th)
- 4. Flatten the paper out and let dry.



What kinds of images do you see in your picture?

Exploration #2

Use the included watercolor paints and half paper plate to create a rainbow:

- 1. Paint a stripe in the order of ROYGBIV (red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo, and violet)
- 2. Let dry completely and then glue clouds (cotton balls) to the ends of the rainbow.



Exploration #3

Use the included watercolor paint to practice color mixing! You can do this right on the paper or you can mix on a washable plate. Start with two colors and then add more to see what you get.
